

PROCEEDINGS OF A TOWN MEETING

Hebron Township 10206 Seaman Hebron, Illinois 60034

June 12, 2024

CALL TO ORDER - At the Regular Town Meeting, held in the town of Hebron, County of McHenry, and State of Illinois, at 7:00p.m. on the 12th day of June was called to order by Nancy Lech, Township Supervisor. The Pledge of Allegiance and roll call were accepted by Deputy Clerk Jennifer Nickels from the prior Hearing.

APPROVAL OF PRIOR MINUTES – Regular May 8, 2024 meeting minutes – Trustee Von Bergen motion to approve the minutes. Second Trustee Werra. Roll call vote Ayes – 4: Trustee Von Bergen, Trustee Reed, Supervisor Lech, Trustee Werra. Nays – 0. Absent – Trustee Mayerck, Clerk Elswick. Motion passed.

APPROVAL OF EXPENDITURES/BILLS –Town Fund Bills – Trustee Werra motion to approve Town Fund expenditures of \$11,958.63, General Assistance Fund expenditures of \$447.73, Cemetery Fund expenditures of \$803.83, Road District Road & Bridge expenditures of \$8,015.55, Hard Road Fund expenditures of \$11,669.64. Second Trustee Reed. Roll call vote Ayes – 4: Trustee Von Bergen, Trustee Reed, Supervisor Lech, Trustee Werra. Nays – 0. Absent – Trustee Mayerck. Motion passed.

ELECTED OFFICIAL & COMMITTEE REPORTS

PLANNING COMMISSION –There was no meeting, there was discussion on temporary use permit application for 6110 Greenwood Rd.

ASSESSOR – Assessor Combs reported 9 sales, 21 inquiries, tax bills & assessment notices now available to receive electronically go to county site to sign up, site visits on new construction & updating front photos in Kennedy, continue to update PRCs, site visit letters sent out to make appointments that still need done for 2024 books, working on the books & still hoping to have them turned in by target date of July. Assessor Association Mtg was 06/03/24 5pm @ Algonquin Twp with a rep from Lake County.

HIGHWAY COMMISSIONER – Commissioner Nickels reported finished 1st round mowing half way through 2nd, patching, cutting brush, hauling material, hired Bass to help with downed tree in middle of the night, another 6 weeks for truck#2 to be done, got rid of 42 TVs on township, replaced signs, working on equipment, worked for Greenwood 4 days, grinding up Thayer Rd, meeting with county on VanderKarr Bridge, Button Rd updates.

TRUSTEES – There were no trustee reports at this time.

SUPERVISOR: CEMETERY – 2 staking, 0 grave sale. Road District cleaned up cemetery grounds before cemetery walk. Cemetery walk generated \$100 donation, placed flags on Veteran’s graves for Memorial Day with Johnny Eskridge, Karen Lalor, Dawn Schinia & Nancy Lech. Working on a new database for the Veteran’s graves flags as Johnny has done is so many times, he has it memorized. GENERAL ASSISTANCE – 1 continued GA, 1 inquiry coming in 06/13, homeless family were staying at the cemetery so spoke with them & gave them some resources, spoke with PADS regarding their situation, they are no longer staying at the cemetery. SUPERVISOR – Audit continues, Treasurer’s Report is finished – just have to wait until the Auditor completes the IL Comptroller Report and then Clerk can file with the County. Purchased cleaning cart for Sue, new trash cans for bathrooms.

CLERK – Records retention continues, purchased additional folders & binders for permanent records. Made a home visit to notarize for a shut in.

OLD BUSINESS – There was continued discussion Township participation in the Village 4th of July Parade, Zeke will bring Township truck, Nancy, Sammie will be behind with the kids & bikes, will be offering decorating materials beforehand. Postponed any letters of recommendation to the County Board regarding VanderKarr Rd Bridge, if need to will bring up again.

NEW BUSINESS – Town Budget & Appropriation – Deputy Clerk Nickels recognized the changes made to the original posted budget as listed in Exhibit A:

Road District Budget & Appropriation – Trustee Von Bergen motion to Adopt Road District Budget & Appropriation Ordinance #RD2024-25. Second Trustee Werra. Roll call vote Ayes – 4: Trustee Von Bergen, Trustee Reed, Supervisor Lech, Trustee Werra. Nays – 0. Absent – Trustee Mayerck. Motion passed.

PUBLIC COMMENTS – There were no public comments at this time.

ADJOURNMENT – Trustee Von Bergen motion to adjourn. Second Trustee Reed. Unanimous voice vote, meeting adjourned at 7:22pm.
