

PROCEEDINGS OF A TOWN MEETING

April 10, 2024

CALL TO ORDER - At the Regular Town Meeting, held in the town of Hebron, County of McHenry, and State of Illinois, at 7:03p.m. on the 10th day of April 2024 was called to order by Nancy Lech, Township Supervisor. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Present – Trustee Mike Von Bergen, Trustee Becky Werra, Trustee Sue Reed, Trustee Sammie Mayerck, Supervisor Nancy Lech, Clerk Patricia Elswick, Road Commissioner Zeke Nickels. Absent - Assessor Shannon Combs.

APPROVAL OF PRIOR MINUTES – Regular March 13, 2024, meeting minutes – Trustee Mayerck motion to approve the minutes. Second Trustee Werra. Roll call vote Ayes – 4: Trustee Von Bergen, Supervisor Lech, Trustee Werra, Trustee Mayerck. Nays – 0. Abstain – Trustee Reed. Motion passed. Decennial March 13, 2024 Minutes – Trustee Werra motioned to approve the minutes. Second Trustee Mayerck. Roll call vote Ayes – 4: Trustee Von Bergen, Supervisor Lech, Trustee Werra, Trustee Mayerck. Nays – 0. Abstain – Trustee Reed. Motion passed.

APPROVAL OF EXPENDITURES/BILLS - Trustee Reed motion to approve Town Fund expenditures of \$11,399.23, General Assistance Fund expenditures of \$438.51, Cemetery Fund expenditures of \$215.30, Road District Road & Bridge expenditures of \$3760.79, Hard Road Fund expenditures of \$7200.37. Second Trustee Von Bergen. Roll call vote Ayes – 5 Trustee Von Bergen, Trustee Reed, Supervisor Lech, Trustee Werra, Trustee Mayerck. Nays – 0. Motion Passed.

ELECTED OFFICIAL & COMMITTEE REPORTS

PLANNING COMMISSION – There was no report at this time.

ASSESSOR – Assessor Combs at state meeting. report given to Supervisor Lech.

HIGHWAY COMMISSIONER – Commissioner Nickels reported plowing, salting, patching, brush, working on equipment, railroad is complete & they are tweaking some things, no updates on the bridge.

TRUSTEES – There was no report at this time.

SUPERVISOR: CEMETERY – 0 staking, 1 grave sale.

GENERAL ASSISTANCE – 1 continued General Assistance.

SUPERVISOR – Hastings Asphalt updated information and answered questions on sealcoating. Completed quarterly payroll reports. Fiscal year end information and reports boxed & ready for audit. The voting site was well received by Election judges and voters. HB5050 with attached HB5050HA1 has passed out of committee on a partisan roll call. SB103 is where townships may regulate solar energy facilities and prevail over County regulations but not over municipal regulations.

CLERK – Continuing to work on logging documents for record retention. Trustee Von Bergen motion to enter corrections into the text of the February 14, 2024 minutes to reflect the amounts approved in the bills & expenditures for Town, GA, Cemetery and Hard Road Funds. Second Trustee Mayerck. Roll call vote Ayes – 5 Trustee Von Bergen, Trustee Reed, Supervisor Lech, Trustee Werra, Trustee Mayerck. Nays – 0. Motion Passed.

OLD BUSINESS – Pollinator Program – Trustee Von Bergen will have FFA teacher & AH Principal out to go over area and information. Trustee Werra motion to allocate 1 acre of land to the AH FFA & Township Pollinator Program. Second Trustee Reed. Roll call vote Ayes – 5 Trustee Von Bergen, Trustee Reed, Supervisor Lech, Trustee Werra, Trustee Mayerck. Nays – 0. Motion Passed. Parking Lot Sealcoating – Low amount given by Hastings with the same linear feet. Trustee Werra motioned to approve Hastings. Seconded Trustee Von Bergen. Roll call vote Ayes – 4: Trustee Von

Bergen, Supervisor Lech, Trustee Werra, Trustee Mayerck. Nays – 0. Abstain – Trustee Reed. Motion passed. Fourth of July Parade – Discussion & continue next month. Letters of Recommendation to the County regarding VanderKarr Rd – there was discussion and will wait to send a letter with continued monitoring of progress as the bid opening is set for May 8, 2024 and talks of up to \$320K with a fix this year.

NEW BUSINESS – There was no new business at this time.

PUBLIC COMMENTS – There was no public comments at this time.

ADJOURNMENT – Trustee Von Bergen motion to adjourn. Second Trustee Werra. Unanimous voice vote, meeting adjourned at 8:01pm.
