

PROCEEDINGS OF A TOWN MEETING

May 8, 2024

CALL TO ORDER - At the Regular Town Meeting, held in the town of Hebron, County of McHenry, and State of Illinois, at 7:09p.m. on the 8th day of May 2024 was called to order by Nancy Lech, Township Supervisor. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Present – Trustee Mike Von Bergen, Trustee Sue Reed, Trustee Becky Werra, Trustee Sammie Mayerck, Supervisor Nancy Lech, Clerk Patricia Elswick, Road Commissioner Zeke Nickels & Assessor Shannon Combs.

APPROVAL OF PRIOR MINUTES – Regular April 10, 2024, meeting minutes – Trustee Mayerck motion to approve the minutes. Second Trustee Reed. Roll call vote Ayes – 5: Trustee Von Bergen, Trustee Reed, Supervisor Lech, Trustee Werra, Trustee Mayerck. Nays – 0. Motion passed. April 22, 2024 Budget Workshop Minutes with correction of Trustee Mayerck recorded absent – Trustee Von Bergen motion to approve the minutes. Second Trustee Werra. Roll call vote Ayes – 5: Trustee Von Bergen, Trustee Reed, Supervisor Lech, Trustee Werra. Nays – 0. Abstain – Trustee Mayerck. Motion passed.

APPROVAL OF EXPENDITURES/BILLS - Trustee Werra motion to approve Town Fund expenditures of \$15,466.56, General Assistance Fund expenditures of \$447.62, Cemetery Fund expenditures of \$322.95, Road District Road & Bridge expenditures of \$3,135.51, Hard Road Fund expenditures of \$9,408.32. Second Trustee Mayerck. Roll call vote Ayes – 5 Trustee Von Bergen, Trustee Reed, Supervisor Lech, Trustee Werra, Trustee Mayerck. Nays – 0. Motion Passed.

ELECTED OFFICIAL & COMMITTEE REPORTS

PLANNING COMMISSION – Met & wrote letter of recommendation regarding 10310 Button Rd. Trustee Werra motion to approve the letter(exhibit A) Second Trustee Reed. Roll call vote Ayes – 5 Trustee Von Bergen, Trustee Reed, Supervisor Lech, Trustee Werra, Trustee Mayerck. Nays – 0. Motion passed.

ASSESSOR – Assessor Combs reported tax bills are available online & will be mailed out soon, 14 sales since April meeting including 1 new home & 1 resale of a model, office inquiries are up.

HIGHWAY COMMISSIONER – Commissioner Nickels reported 75-ton, patching, garbage, community mulch, clearing storm damage, 2 after hours tree falls, brush, grade gravel, 2 days in cemetery working on the tree line, HR Green is to help with the Green St grant \$1000 & engineering, IDOT consult on repairs needed to control water spots, the new lights at the railroad crossing were stolen & out next day to replace, OSHA visit, County Engineer on Vander Karr Rd out next week, repaired cemetery driveway and picked up Christmas wreaths.

TRUSTEES – There was no report at this time.

SUPERVISOR: CEMETERY – 1 staking, 0 grave sales. Cemetery Board met 04/25/24 reviewed Cemetery Rules & Regulations, small changes were made & Supervisor Lech will make an electronic copy of rules for future so they do not need to be re-created. Cemetery will review at July meeting then bring to Township Board in August 2024 for approval, Nancy & Tim installed new solar light on flagpole, met with banker about CD's, updated information form & sent it to funeral homes.

GENERAL ASSISTANCE – 1 continued General Assistance.

SUPERVISOR – Weeded township building flower beds/trees Zeke & Kurt helped with mulch, Kurt fixed toilet in woman's restroom, Audit has started, installed lock on water hydrant.

CLERK – No updates on record retention need to get supplies.

OLD BUSINESS – Pollinator Program – Trustee Von Bergen working with AH FFA on site location. Fourth of July Parade – discussed no participation this year. Letters of Recommendation to the County regarding VanderKarr Rd – new letters were reviewed, should wait until results of bid opening are reviewed.

NEW BUSINESS – Set budget hearing dates for Town & Road District – Trustee Von Bergen motion to set Town Budget Hearing for 6:40pm, Road District Hearing for 6:50pm, Final Hearings for both during the Regular Township Meeting June 12, 2024 7:00pm. Second Trustee Reed. Roll call vote Ayes – 5 Trustee Von Bergen, Trustee Reed, Supervisor Lech, Trustee Werra, Trustee Mayerck. Nays – 0. Motion passed. Discussion/action closing Cemetery CD's – Trustee Von Bergen made motion giving the Supervisor the authority to close the following Cemetery CDs at the Harvard State Bank: #4959 \$3000 maturity date 09/01/24, #1600144 \$7500 maturity date 10/28/27, #0001045 \$2000 maturity date 10/05/26. Second Trustee Werra. Roll call vote Ayes – 5 Trustee Von Bergen, Trustee Reed, Supervisor Lech, Trustee Werra, Trustee Mayerck. Nays – 0. Motion passed.

PUBLIC COMMENTS – Thanks to the Board for helping Road Commissioner, thanks to Zeke & Road District for the Cemetery help. The Historical Society is hosting a cemetery walk June 1st with 50% of proceeds back to Linn Cemetery.

ADJOURNMENT – Trustee Reed motion to adjourn. Second Trustee Werra. Unanimous voice vote, meeting adjourned at 8:11pm.
