

PROCEEDINGS OF A TOWN MEETING

August 14, 2024

CALL TO ORDER - At the Regular Town Meeting, held in the town of Hebron, County of McHenry, and State of Illinois, at 7:00p.m. on the 14th day of August was called to order by Nancy Lech, Township Supervisor. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Present – Trustee Mike Von Bergen, Trustee Sue Reed, Trustee Becky Werra, Trustee Sammie Mayerck, Supervisor Nancy Lech, Clerk Patricia Elswick, Road Commissioner Zeke Nickels & Assessor Shannon Combs.

APPROVAL OF PRIOR MINUTES – Regular July 10, 2024, Meeting minutes – Trustee Mayerck motion to approve the minutes. Second Trustee Werra. Roll call vote Ayes – 4: Trustee Von Bergen, Supervisor Lech, Trustee Werra, Trustee Mayerck. Nays – 0. Abstain – Trustee Reed. Motion passed.

APPROVAL OF EXPENDITURES/BILLS –Town Fund Bills – Trustee Werra motion to approve Town Fund expenditures of \$18,802.73, General Assistance Fund expenditures of \$679.31, Cemetery Fund expenditures of \$6,672.26, Road District Road & Bridge expenditures of \$19,361.44, Hard Road Fund expenditures of \$12,533.34. Second Trustee Mayerck. Roll call vote Ayes – 5: Trustee Von Bergen, Trustee Reed, Supervisor Lech, Trustee Werra, Trustee Mayerck. Nays – 0. Motion passed.

ELECTED OFFICIAL & COMMITTEE REPORTS

PLANNING COMMISSION –There was no meeting.

ASSESSOR – Assessor Combs reported 11 inquiries, 2 in office appointments, 8 sales, still working on books.

HIGHWAY COMMISSIONER – Commissioner Nickels reported working on patching, signs, garbage, complete mow in 6 days, equipment, brush from storms, 2 sheriff calls, worked with Greenwood Twp & Seneca Twp on 1/3 mile in Giant Oaks, Greenwood Twp paying for the 700 feet within Hebron Twp, cut brush back, Greenwood Twp paved 1000 ft of Thayer Rd also paid by Greenwood Twp, reditched @ Harrison & 173 by State IDOT hopefully will correct culverts, Curran to start repaving Button Rd on Monday, new tires on payload, replaced tire on mower with roadside assistance, 1 driveway permit, 2 overweight permits, helped the Food Pantry with deliveries while parking lot was sealed.

TRUSTEES – Trustee Von Bergen reported on the ongoing County Stormwater Ordinance changes.

SUPERVISOR: CEMETERY – 1 staking, 0 grave sales. At the July 25th Cemetery Board meeting they reviewed rules & regulations, updated for the Township Board to review & approve, created electronic version for future updates, renewed cemetery license. GENERAL ASSISTANCE – 1 continued GA, 1 denied GA. SUPERVISOR – Received thank you from Food Pantry, parking lot sealed & striped, audit is complete, worked on salaries for new term 2025-2029, met with 2 landscape vendors for quote on front of the building.

CLERK – Records retention continues, filed budget with County Clerk, filed Decennial report with County Board, attending a records retention webinar on Friday, Consolidated Election packets are available for circulation next week.

OLD BUSINESS – There was some discussion on the proposed salaries for 2025-2029 Salary Ordinance, postpone action until next month.

NEW BUSINESS – Trustee Werra motion to approve the Cemetery Rules & Regulations as presented by the Cemetery Board. Second Trustee Mayerck. Roll call vote Ayes – 5: Trustee Von Bergen, Trustee Reed, Supervisor Lech, Trustee Werra, Trustee Mayerck. Nays – 0. Motion passed. There was discussion on tree removal in the Cemetery, postpone action until next month. /Discussion on front landscaping, postponed action until next month. Trustee Von Bergen motion to accept Trustee Susan Reed’s resignation effective August 15, 2024. Second Trustee Mayerck. Roll call vote Ayes – 5: Trustee Von Bergen, Trustee Reed, Supervisor Lech, Trustee Werra, Trustee Mayerck. Motion passed.

PUBLIC COMMENTS – Township resident is holding a meeting to gather information on concerns of Village residents for those considering running for Village offices at the upcoming Consolidated Election, this is not a Township Meeting.

ADJOURNMENT – Trustee Werra motion to adjourn. Second Trustee Reed. Unanimous voice vote, meeting adjourned at 8:19pm.
