PLANNING COMMISSION –There was no meeting.

ASSESSOR – Assessor Combs reported 12 inquiries, 3 sales, hoping to get books done asap.

HIGHWAY COMMISSIONER – Commissioner Nickels reported patching, garbage, signs, equipment, storm clean up out until midnight, Greenwood cleaned too, helped Village of Hebron push trees, cleaned corn field debris from culverts, worked 3 days with Greenwood & Dunham, Thayer Rd rescheduled, Button to continue when dry, 4th of July parade, generator was helpful when power was out for more than 24hrs, VanderKarr bridge bid opening & will know soon.
