CALL TO ORDER - At the Regular Town Meeting, held in the town of Hebron, County of McHenry, and State of Illinois, at 7:02p.m. on the 11th day of January was called to order by Nancy Lech, Township Supervisor. PLANNING COMMISSION – No planning commission report at this time.

ASSESSOR – Assessor Combs reported 3 sales since December meeting, reported on appeals, filing exemptions and hearings & non-hearings that are scheduled for end of January. Still currently working on appeals submitted to try and settle before hearings. County will not likely to roll over until late February then will start processing exemptions. Many site visits will be needed. HIGHWAY COMMISSIONER – Commissioner Nickels reported maintenance and repairs on grader for possible blizzard that never came, Truck#7 updates on repairs, meeting with potential new gravel pit on Burgett Rd, patching, cutting brush, plowing, working on equipment, did clearing house queries, investigated a potential grant & waiting to hear back on a meeting with Brad Schinerds office for more information.

Received Tax Levy confirmation as exactly what we levied for. Letter from IL DOR regarding cemetery PIN & has been classified as exempt property. Signed off on Colton Vanderstappen's Eagle Scout project. All Quarterly & yearly reports completed, W-2's distributed and electronically filed SSA.
